

Bonby Lane, sharp bend near Birkwood – Cllr Knott pointed out that several cars had gone into the verge on this sharp bend. Clerk to raise this with Highways and suggest some kind of warning system for motorists, chevrons or reflective bollards for example.

Mud on road near the pond – Cllr Knott was concerned about the amount of mud on the road near to the village pond. Clerk to inform highways.

Dog warden – There was dissatisfaction with the service provided by the dog warden in relation to a dog that is persistently roaming free in the village. Clerk to request that the SDC officer responsible for the dog warden service attend the next meeting of the parish council.

Jefferson Arms – [Councillor Knott declared an interest and left the meeting]. It had been brought to the clerk's attention that a stainless steel flue on the southern aspect of the Jefferson Arms might require planning consent. Clerk to write to SDC planning department for clarification.
